Most Christians I've met don't think they have a lot to give to the work of God's Kingdom, but the fact is that every Christian has an extremely powerful gift to share with people. It's their **personal story** of what God did to bring them from spiritual darkness into the light of His salvation. Nobody else has your story. Some may be similar, but they aren't **your story**. Only you have your story and it's a story people need to hear. In fact, I believe God will use every Christian's salvation story to speak powerfully to at least one unsaved person about their need for salvation.

When I was saved from atheism in 1971 I knew little about the Bible, but I knew "my story" of how God saved me and He gave me a lot of opportunities to share it. I worked every day to improve the way I told my story. It quickly became the most important thing in my life.

I started Bible College in 1974 and one of the first things I was asked to do was write my faith story as part of the application process. That was a great experience and showed me how powerful it is to **write** as well as **tell** your salvation story. If you haven't done so already, I highly recommend that you write out your faith story and share it with someone in your life.
